Main Points

- Pros still Play for Cash Only.
- Amateur and Advanced Players payouts increase 25%
- More CTP Prizes for the end of year tournament.
- Yearly Course Improvements to the courses we play

Amateur and Advanced Players payouts increase 25%

By partnering with Gotta Go, Gotta Throw we can increase payouts to you 25%. So when you pay the entry fee, it's like getting the Ace Pool Free! Your \$4 Division portion goes to \$5 overall.

Amateur Players \$5 Entry (Same \$1 Ace, \$4 Division)

Something Old, Something New, **Position Payouts**. This is a similar payout system that I created when we started GGGT. Simply put, players of all skill levels have a shot at the \$14 GC while still rewarding top players. **Payout Positions are: 1st, 2nd, 7th, 8th, 13th, 14th, 19th, 20th, etc...** For every 3 Amateur players we will award a \$14 GGGT Gift Certificate. So 15 players will get paid 5 positions! 13th place out of 17 would win a \$14 GGGT GC. A small portion of the entry fee goes into a special CTP Slush Fund for additional prizes, more about that later.

Advanced Players \$5 Entry (Same \$1 Ace, \$4 Division)

Same Top Third Payouts, but payouts increase **20%** and the additional **5%** increase goes into a special CTP Slush fund for additional prizes. So with 20 Advanced Players, instead of paying \$25 cash, 1st place gets \$30.00 GC. The 5% portion is \$1.25 for Slush Fund Prizes.

More CTP Prizes for the end of year tournament

100% of the Slush Fund gets paid out at the end of the year tournament or with other prizes I choose to award to players. This will also be used to start new things like the Birdie Bangers Club. This program will be out in 2010 where the top Birdie maker in the division gets a custom Birdie Banger Club Mini Color Coded for each course, but more on that later.

Yearly Course Improvements to the courses played

Gotta Go, Gotta Throw will use a portion of the proceeds they make from the stuff (Discs, Shirts, Hats, Shoes, Bags, etc.) and let the players choose where to spend it on improvements for the courses we play. So for example, Plymouth Creek's basket 8, could there be a new one in its future, who knows it's up to how many players play and what they want, I can only guide.

Cash Option for Prizes

Ok, so you like what I said but you still want the cash. No Problem! I will convert the GGGT Gift Certificate at 70% face value. Some of the extra money from the exchange rate goes back into the Slush Fund for Prizes.

So for the Amateur win of \$14, they will get \$9.80 Cash. Advanced player that won \$30 now gets \$21 Cash.

However, for maximum impact for everyone, I will encourage choosing the Gift Certificate Option!
